Just like in architecture, I love combining creative ideas with analytical thinking and a strong sense for problem-solving. My experience in designing for the end user naturally carries over into frontend development.

I love seeing instant results, refining designs through quick updates, and creating interfaces that feel intuitive and engaging. Skilled in React.js, JavaScript, HTML, and CSS, I enjoy bringing structure and aesthetics together in my work. Always curious and eager to learn, I am looking for a role where I can grow as a developer and contribute to meaningful projects, especially exploring mobile and cross-platform interfaces.

FRONTEND DEVELOPER – 2024 - present / portfolio projects and collaborative volunteer work

Developed responsive web applications using React, JavaScript, and modern UI libraries, and built a personal website to showcase my work. Most of my projects were built with reusable components and a clear component-based architecture to ensure scalability and maintainability. Project highlights include:

- **ByteBar** - a cocktail discovery app combining multiple search features with public APIs and an AI generator, built with secure, serverless backend logic.
- **Clean Plate** - a responsive React app for browsing and filtering recipes using local data.
- **Eventinder** - a full-stack React and Node app featuring a custom REST API for browsing and filtering events.

Currently part of a volunteer developer team, collaborating with **Women's Coding Club** and **Rotterdam Women in Tech**, on an e-commerce prototype built with React, Next.js and Tailwind CSS. Work focuses on component implementation, responsive UI, clear user flows and collaborative version control via GitLab.
